POOL: 25 yard, 8 lane pool with non-turbulent racing lane lines. Horn start, with

custom designed starting blocks. Daktronics Timing System will be used. 20 yard, 4 lane cool down pool will be available.

RULE

AUTHORITY: * 2009 USA Swimming Rules and Regulations and Missouri Valley Swimming Rules will govern the meet.

- * MVS Safety Guidelines and warm-up procedures will apply.
- * All coaches and deck officials must be able to prove, to the satisfaction of the referee, that they hold a current USA Swimming membership.
- * Exhibition swimming is not allowed.
- * All swimmers must be registered and in good standing with USA Swimming for 2009.
- * The swimmer's age on the first day of the meet determines his/her age for the entire meet.
- * Swimsuits worn by all 14 & under competitors shall not cover the neck, extend past the shoulders, nor below the knee. Suits worn in competition must be non-transparent. The use of more than one swimsuit at a time is prohibited, as well as any competition suits not on the FINA approved list. The Referee shall have the authority to bar offenders from the competition until they comply with the rule."

SEEDING:

- * Entry times must be "Yard" times only.
- * "No Time" entries will be seeded in the slowest heats.
- * The meet will be pre-seeded, with the exception of the 500 Free, 1000 Free and 400IM.
- * For these events, positive check-in will be required, heats will be swum fastest to slowest, alternating Women then Men and swimmers will be expected to provide their own timers and counters.
- * There will be a break before the start of the 1000 Free and 400IM.

ENTRIES:

- * Friday: 8 & under swimmers are limited to Four (4) individual events and 1 relay. 12 & under and Open swimmers are limited to Two (2) individual events and 1 relay.
- * Saturday & Sunday: Swimmers are limited to Four (4) individual events and 1 relay each day.
- * Swimmers are limited to 1 session per day, on Saturday & Sunday.

- * Entries should be submitted on Hy-Tek format with entry times in yards.
- * USA Swimming registration number for all athletes MUST be included with the entries or the entries will not be accepted.
- * Entries will be limited to the first 500 swimmers, based on date and time that entries are received. Teams will not be split.
- * E-mailed Hy-Tek zip files will be accepted as described in "Entry Deadline" below.
- * Hy-tek event list download will be available on the MV website.

ENTRY FEES:

- * Individual events are \$3.50 per event. Relays are \$5.00 per relay team.
- * Make checks payable to Kansas City Swim Academy or KCSA.
- * Deck entries will be accepted, at the discretion of the referee and must be turned in 30 minutes prior to the start of the session. The fees are \$7.00 per individual event and \$10.00 per relay.

- * "Fastest Human 50 FREE": Trophies will be given to the fastest male and female in each age group (8-U, 9/10, 11/12, 13/14, and OPEN)
- * "Endurance Award": Trophies will be given to the fastest female and male in each of these events: 8-U 50Fly, 9-10 100 Fly, 11-12 100 Fly, 13-14 500Free, Open-1000 Free.

COACHES

MEETING:

* At the discretion of the referee, a coaches meeting may be held 15 minutes before the morning session.

WARM-UP:

- * Lane assignments will be emailed to the coaches prior to the meet and will be contained in the coaches packets.
- * Swimmers may not dive into the pool during general warm-up. Swimmers must enter the pool by stepping in feet first, or sitting and sliding in, in a safe and cautious manner. Entering in any other manner may result in the disqualification from one or more of the swimmer's events for that session at the discretion of the Meet Referee. Swimmers may dive during a designated sprint warm up.

CONCESSIONS: * Full concessions will be available during the meet.

MEET RESULTS: * At the conclusion of the final session, meet results will be available for any coach who provides a USB memory stick.

* Finals results will be posted on the Missouri Valley website and may include the swimmer's name, age, times, and USA swimming number.
